Discussion: Stanley Black & Decker is committed to reducing the impact of our business on the environment by placing a priority on complying with environmental, health and safety standards for our products and manufacturing operations. This commitment includes monitoring the materials used in our products for global compliance with all applicable legislation covering banned and restricted substances.

Applicability: This Policy applies to all Stanley Black & Decker facilities worldwide.

Position Statement: Stanley Black & Decker does not knowingly use banned or restricted substances above their restricted limit in its products that it sells onto the global market.

Stanley Black & Decker monitors applicable global legislation relating to the restriction of the substances used in our products. This information is used to define a process (ES100118) that includes our Supply Chain partners and enables Stanley Black & Decker to reasonably ensure that banned or restricted substances are not knowingly used in its products.

Stanley Black & Decker uses an appropriate monitoring process to audit the presence of banned or restricted substances in our products. Using this monitoring process, should a non compliance be determined then Stanley Black & Decker works with our Supply Chain partners to prevent the future use of any restricted or banned substances from our products.

Policy: All Stanley Black & Decker and third party locations engaged in the procurement, design and manufacturing of products are required to comply with the requirements relating to restricted substances contained in ES100118, attached hereto, and this policy.
