



California Voluntary Carbon Markets Disclosure¹

Stanley Black & Decker (the “Company”) publishes statements and reports on its website describing its greenhouse gas (“GHG”) emissions²; its emissions targets, which have been approved by the Science Based Targets initiative; and progress on its emissions targets, which is monitored through year-to-year comparisons. Such statements and reports include, but are not limited to, [the Company’s annual impact report](#), [operational metrics](#) and [product sustainability metrics](#) featured on its website, and a [third-party \(LRQA\) GHG emissions assurance statement](#). The Company’s project to harness waste heat to generate power at our Martin, TN factory plant does not create new or additional emissions but rather repurposes existing waste heat from manufacturing to generated electricity before release. This statement has not undergone third-party verification as of the date of this document.

This statement is provided, and only speaks as of January 29, 2026, for those entities that are subject to the VCMDA. The Company does not undertake any obligation or intention to update or revise any forward-looking statements, whether as a result of future events or circumstances, new information or otherwise, except as required by law.
